

**You do need a driver's license number to file a federal return. States require your driver's license number for state tax returns because they have the ability to match state records and help confirm your identity. This is one more layer of protection against identity thieves. State tax software will prompt you for your driver's license number if it is requested by the state. Alabama is one of the states that require driver's license/ID number, date issued, expiration date, and state issued. On joint returns both the taxpayer and spouse's info are required.**
